7th Grade Math

We have started Unit 1 on Ratios and Proportions. Students should bring homework home about 2 to 3 times each week to complete. Please be sure you are checking with your student about their homework

completion. Just like in sports, math needs to be practiced to build skills. We also encourage you to check TeacherEase regularly to keep up with your student's overall grades and any missing assignments. If you are unsure how to access TeacherEase, please contact the 7th grade guidance at 444-3419.

When your student is absent, they are responsible for any work missed. Students are responsible for checking with their teachers for missed work. **Any work that is missing is entered as a zero in TeacherEase until it is made up.** It is important to your student's success to keep up with all assigned work. If you or your student have questions about the assigned work, please contact their math teacher. If your student is struggling with work at home, they can use the Paper app in Clever for one-on-one support/tutoring that is available 24 hours a day.

Your student should be coming to school everyday with the necessary supplies to be successful. This includes pencils, agenda book, notebooks (paper), and a charged Chromebook. It is important that Chromebooks be charged as teachers do not have extra Chromebooks or chargers to lend out. If your child

Thank you for your involvement and support in your child's education. By working together, we will increase your child's opportunity for success.


7th Grade Social Studies

8th Grade Math

Daily attendance is extremely important. Students may struggle to complete the math assignments without attending classes and participating in class discussions/notes. It is important for students to ask questions when they are stuck in class. If a student is still confused after instruction, please send your math teacher an email to request tutoring before or after school. Math builds on itself daily so students should seek help before they get too far behind. All students are working on computers but should still have paper and pencils for notes and offline activities. Please check with vour student and make sure that they have all their supplies to be successful in classes. Additionally, please remind your student to charge his/her Chromebook every night and especially over the weekend. 8th Grade Pre-Algebra is continuing to work through geometry units, specifically angle relationships and Algebra is solving multistep equations.

8th Grade Language Arts

We made it through the first full month of school. We are beginning Unit 1 in StudySync, introducing academic vocabulary, and all kinds of sentences. We are concentrating on standards: RL.8.1, RL.8.2, RL.8.4,L.8.1 and L.8.4. 
