#### **Attendance**

Our mission in District 118 is to promote school success and nurture lifelong learners. We hope to see all our students attend daily. Please remember if a student is absent an adult needs to call 217-444-3404 with a reason within 48 hours to excuse student or it will be counted as an unexcused absence. When a student has accumulated six total absences (excused or unexcused,) a doctor's note will be required for every absence thereafter. By law, nine or more unexcused absences requires the school to refer this case to the truancy officer and to an appropriate child welfare agency in order to correct this situation.

Initiatives: Students on truancy list monitoring attendance with zero unexcused absences each month will receive free gift for improving attendance.

#### **Home Liaisons**
