



Main Focus: Different levels of questioning for grades K - 4.



- · Readers can point to the answer within the text.
- · These are "right there" factual answers.
- Question starters include words like: define, describe, name, identify or list.



Level 2: Text Implicit (a little more challenging)

- Between the lines: "From the Book and the Brain".
- Readers infer answers from what the text states & find answers in several places in
- Question starters include words like: analyze, group, infer, & compare and contrast. Level 3: Experience Based (often the most difficult for students)
- Off the pages of the text and only from the brain.
- · Readers think beyond what the text says & activate prior knowledge.
- Question starters include words like: evaluate, predict, & imagine
