Reminders from Nurse High

The following will need to be in your student's file before your student can start Kindergarten on 8/10/23:

Current Physical (dated 8/10/2022 or after)-this <u>must</u> include blood lead screening and diabetes risk assessment

Current, up to date immunization record

Eye Examination by an Optometrist or Waiver (Due by 10/15/2023)

Dental Exam (Due by 5/15/2024)

The sooner you get these completed and turned into the nurse's office, the better. Doctors' offices get very busy over the summer with school physicals and immunizations, which can make it difficult to get an appointment. Getting everything completed as soon as possible will make your Kindergarten registration process easier. If you have any questions or concerns, please contact the school nurse.

Erica Davis is our social work intern this year. She will be working with students and helping with all the activities above!



Reminders from Nurse High

Special Health Needs

If your child has any special health needs or concerns this should be communicated to me. This information can be very important to a successful experience in school. Examples of such needs are:

- 1. Food Allergy
- 2. Bee sting allergy
- 3. Allergy to any other substance
- 4. Difficulty with vision, hearing or speech
- 5. Need for medication during the school day

6. Need for special aids such as crutches, walkers or wheelchairs, either on a temporary or permanent basis.

Attention parents of students with food allergies: In order for your child to receive a food substitution at school, a food substitution form must be completed by your child's physician and returned to the school nurse. These forms were sent home by the nurses at the beginning of the school year to the parents of students with known allergies. There are still many students who do not have this form turned in, and the only way for food service to know to make a substitution is to have the form completed. It is imperative for the safety of your child that you get this form completed and turned in ASAP. If you need another copy of the form, please contact your school nurse.

IS MY CHILD TOO SICK TO GO TO SCHOOL?

Here are general guidelines to use when determining if your child should stay home from school:

- -Temperature over 100.0 degrees/any fever within the last 24 hours
- -Vomiting within the past 24 hours
- -Frequent diarrhea stools; 3 or more within the last 24 hours
- -Difficulty breathing
- -Open sores that are draining and oozing
- -Persistent coughing
- -White part of eye is red and there is draining or oozing
- -Unexplained rash
- -Child acts or looks sick

This is a good time to remind your child about good handwashing, coughing into their sleeve, and keeping their hands away from their mouth, nose and eyes.

If your child is going to be absent from school, please call the school the morning of their absence at 217-444-3500.


