In addition to selecting electives, families should also consider the following options for the 2024-25 school year.

Algebra and Biology - Eighth grade students can take Algebra 1 and Biology at NRMS. This is a great opportunity for your child to get a head-start on high school. Students that successfully complete these classes will be awarded high school credit and can take more advanced classes during their 9th grade year.

AVID – AVID's mission is to “close the opportunity gap by preparing all students for college readiness and success in a global society.” North Ridge Middle School's AVID program fulfills this mission through the implementation of AVID principles school-wide and through the AVID elective course including tutorials, organizational skills, and college visits. Any student interested in AVID can apply by filling out an AVID application, which can be picked up in the guidance office.

High School Prep Program – The high school prep program is an alternative education placement at the Kenneth D. Bailey Academy that has been in place for many years. Students choose this program because it offers:

1. High school credits earned in “summer school” after their 8th grade year.
2. Smaller classroom setting
3. Community outreach and field trips
4. High school preparation
5. Specific student growth goals

English and Math Support Classes – Many students have fallen behind academically and need extra support to catch up.
